Responsible for fabricating all standard architectural post and panel projects within the Exterior Department. This is the initial stage of fabrication where cuts, files, welds and other types of manipulation are necessary.

Education/Experience

Minimum:

- A high school degree or GED equivalent is required
- Three (3) years of experience in metal manufacturing fabrication

Preferred:

- Certified welding or machine trade school
- Five (5) years of experience in metal fabrication
- MIG and Stick Welding experience

Major Responsibilities

- Assemble all architectural post and panel signage from detailed drawings
- Interpret, install and test lighting components of all illuminated architectural signage
- Prioritize work orders with shipping date and production time
- Inspect work at all times to guarantee an exceptional finished product
- Maintain the condition of your work area, keeping it free from trash and other unnecessary equipment
- Follow company safety policies and procedures
- · Performs other duties as assigned
